DESTINATION - ANNA MEDICAL COLLEGE, MAURITIUS

WHY

1. AMC is recognized by Medical Council of Mauritius (MCM) and accredited by TEC, Mauritius. AMC is listed in the directories of World Health Organization (WHO), Medical council of INDIA (MCI), South African Qualification Authority (SAQA), Foundation for Advancement of International Medical Education and Research (FAIMER), Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG), International Medical Education Directory (IMED), Global Alliance for Medical Education (GAME) which chronicle the accredited medical schools of the world. These listings allow our graduates to be eligible to write various national examinations such as the United States Medical Licensing Examination (USMLE), the Licentiate of the Medical College of Canada (LMCC), and the Diploma of Membership of the Royal Colleges of Physicians of the United Kingdom (MRCP). Degree, the MBBS, awarding body is UTM (university of technology Mauritius), and is one of the 2 government universities in Mauritius for medical education, recognized by MCM.
2. Curriculum is framed suitable to train the candidate to be competent for any qualifying tests of developed countries viz. INDIA, USA, UK, SOUTH AFRICA, etc.
3. The course is of 5 years duration, in phased manner (I, II & III phases) divided into 10 semesters of 6 months each. Program syllabus is similar to MCI, in English medium, 5 years of 10 semesters course study in Mauritius & internship (House surgeon) in the country of origin (eg, for Indian origin candidates, it is in India) for which we guide. House surgeons are to be done in home country of the student for exposure and experience in locally prevalent diseases and medical conditions through medical specialist who are experienced in such countries.
4. For clinical training it is one of the 5 national hospitals of Mauritius, the FLACQ HOSPITAL, situated in the district of Flacq, directly controlled by regional health director, under ministry of health, cater clinical services for about 170,000 through 24 community health centers, 4 area health centers, 1 mediclinic, covering entire health region 3.
5. Dedicated well experienced teaching faculty from India & other countries make the theory & clinical training easy and interesting. The busy schedule not only avoid home sickness, but assure reproducibility by conducting regular chapter ending test on Saturdays and on 4th Saturday Integrate teaching / seminar are conducted. In addition, day to day assessment, basing on their performance in theory & practical classes, not only to infuse confidence to clear any competitive test conducted by the medical regulatory bodies of various countries, further the marks will be added to internal assessment towards university examinations.
6. College 'Central Library' is well furnished with internet, CD-ROMS computers, audio-visual aids and photocopying, with books, journals & e-library, similar to TEC guide lines, and is opened from 8.00 am to 8. 00 pm including Sundays. Book lending facility is provided to students & teachers.
7. Students are provided with opportunities to improve their talents in curricular & extra-curricular, sports and games and are regulated & maintained by student 'welfare department' of the college, under HR unit.

8. Central library, Staff quarters, hostels for boys & girls are within are in the vicinity of the college. Hostels are provided with care takers, round the clock security for girls, monitored by wardens, mentors in addition to chief warden, for strict discipline, for the reason, 1st year hostel stay is made compulsory for the betterment of the student.
9. 'Food committee' monitors food Menu for hostel students where in selected staff & semester wise students are the members. Indian & local chefs provide balanced food through common menu designed to satisfy the international student community, which avoid homesickness for food.
10. Mauritius is a Democratic, safe, pollution free Island Country in south-west Indian Ocean, culture & climate is similar to India, with a population of about 1. 7 million. 85% are Indian origins from all parts of India speak all regional languages of India, mostly from Bihar. English is the official language, Native language is Creole (mixture of French & Jodhpur). Port Louis is the capital city, currency is MUR (Mauritian Rupee) divided into 100 cents. Sir Seewoosagur Ramgoolam international airport is about 48kms from capital.
